Hike Description: Millersylvania State Park is a publicly owned recreation area located 10 miles south of Olympia, Washington. The state park's 842 acres include old-growth cedar and fir trees as well as 3,300 feet of freshwater shoreline on Deep Lake. In addition to appreciating native plants, Jeanne will highlight lichens growing in the park and Cyndy will try to identify mosses.

Special requirements: Discover Pass is required. Wear sturdy walking shoes or rain boots and bring rain gear, if necessary. Cookies and water will be provided.

Directions: From I-5 South, take exit 99. Turn left onto WA-121S/93<sup>rd</sup> Ave S and go 1.5 mi. Turn right onto WA-121S (Tilley Rd. SW) and go 2.6 mi, turning right into small parking area. This parking area is about 0.3 to 0.4 miles north of the main park entrance.
